
Complete First-Timer (No prior speaking experience)

Why first-time speakers matter

Launchpad for new voices

Fresh perspectives break the cycle of repeated ideas

Opportunity to diversify speaker lineups



Proactively Seek First-Time Speakers



Advertise your event for both first-time and experienced speakers



Speaker intake form: Ask if it's their first time



Promote diversity of thought by bringing in people from different backgrounds

Pairing First-Time Speakers with Mentors







Panel sessions: A great format for first-time speakers

Mentorship: Assign a mentor from the event team to guide the firsttime speaker Shared slide creation helps ease the workload

Proactive Communication and Organization

- Clearly communicate deadlines for slides and rehearsals
- Use Teams or collaboration tools for organizing work
- Set expectations early: "When will they be added to the group?"

Rehearsal & Feedback for Confidence







Schedule a rehearsal with first-time speakers

Offer early feedback to fine-tune presentations

Help them with timing and pacing



Guidance on Audience Engagement

- Tips for engaging the audience: Q&A, polls, storytelling
- Handling nerves: Encourage pauses, breathing, and staying conversational
- Focus on visual aids to support their message

Slide Design Support







Provide slide templates or design tips

Encourage limiting text and using visuals

Keep slides aligned with event branding



Encourage Storytelling

- Encourage speakers to tell a story related to their experience with Microsoft products
- Stories help structure the talk and make it more memorable
- Tie stories back to key points in their presentation



Supporting Demo Environments

- Many first-time speakers might not have access to a non-work-related E5 environment
- Offer a shared demo environment for practice
