

Visual content is highly engaging in Yammer and helps to tell the story of your post.

Here's our recommendation for image sizes, however, the display of the image is highly dependent on the device and resolution.

Yammer Community cover photo and icon

Upload a cover photo to share your community's identity, communicate a campaign, or publicize a community event.


Only community admins can update the **Community cover photo**. The cover photo size is 1360 x 550.

For the **Community icon image**, we recommend a square logo. It will be resized to 85 x 85.

Best practice: Use something simple and recognizable because the community branding will be shown across the web and smaller on mobile devices.

Yammer conversations

Try to keep posts short to medium length, 1–2 sentences per paragraph as post people tend to scan. Yammer posts have a 10,000-character limit.



Post images

You can upload 50+ photos at a time. The images you upload should be less than 5,000 x 5,000 pixels to maintain image quality. The maximum image size is 10 MB.

Upload video content from your mobile device



You can record and upload videos directly to Yammer conversations from web or mobile. If you have a recorded video, here are the supported video file types: .wmv, .avi, .mpeg, .3gp, .flv, .mov, .mp4, .mpg, .ogm, .mkv, .ogv, and .ogg. The maximum video size is 10 MB. Add files to your posts

File uploads have a max file size of 10 MB and should be less than 5,000 x 5,000 pixels to maintain image quality. If necessary, you can upload 100 files in a single post.

To delete a file, go to the Yammer page for that file, and then click Delete the file on the right side. Only the owner of the file or the Admin can delete a file.

Admins: Company Logo on homepage

For the dimensions of your logo are max width 196 pixels and max height 180 pixels.



Padding around the logo is built within the page, so there is no need to add padding or buffer within the image.

Our recommendation is to take your logo and scale it to 196 wide. Let the vertical height be determined by the aspect ratio of the logo. If the logo is more tall than wide, scale the image to 180 tall first.
